INFORMATION FOR YARD SALE PARTICIPANTS

- 1. No Rain Date:** The event will be held rain or shine.
- 2. Participant Balloons:** Pick up balloons from 7:30-10:00 am on September 12, at the of Department of Public Works, 75 Chestnut Street. Display balloons in front of your house to help shoppers identify you as a yard sale participant.
- 3. Info Pack:** Copies of the Yard Sale info pack may be picked up at Public Works or printed from **redbankgreen**. This will include a map of participating homes, addresses, and a short description of select items being sold. To deter shoppers from arriving before they are welcome, info packs won't be available until the morning of the event.
- 4. Free Section:** We encourage you to include a "FREE" section in your yard sale. Display a sign letting shoppers know they can help themselves to any items within the free area. This will help reduce our trash costs and keep things out of the landfill that other people could find useful.
- 5. Make a Donation:** Following the sale, consider donating or recycling as many of your leftovers as you can. Below is a list of places that take donations or recyclables.
